

Secondary Colours (orange, purple, green)	Colour Mixing
	Color Mixing Chart  — — — — — — — — — — — — — — — — — — —
A colour made by mixing two primary colours.	Adding two primary colours together to make a secondary colour.
Paint (Watercolour, poster, pastel, acrylic)	Warm
A mixture of liquid used that forms a dry coating when spread on a surface.	Associated with sun, warmth and fire- warm colours evoke warm feelings in people.
