a group of colours from which all other colours can be obtained by mixing.

Secondary Colours (orange, purple, green)



a colour resulting from the mixing of two primary colours.

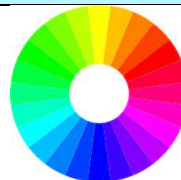

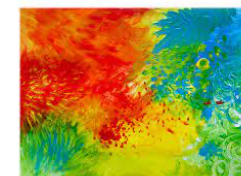
