Development matters	Communication and language	<p><b><u>Listening, Attention and Understanding</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Listen carefully to rhymes and songs, paying attention to how they sound.</li> <li>Understand how to listen carefully and why listening is important.</li> </ul> <p><b><u>Speaking</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Perform rhymes, poems and songs</li> </ul>
	Physical Development	<p><b><u>Gross motor skills</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Develop the overall body strength, co-ordination, balance and agility needed to engage successfully with future physical education sessions and other physical disciplines including dance, gymnastics, sport and swimming.</li> <li>Progress towards a more fluent style of moving, with developing control and grace</li> </ul>
	Expressive Arts and Design	<p><b><u>Being Imaginative</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Sing in a group or on their own, increasingly matching the pitch and following the melody.</li> <li>Explore and engage in music making and dance, performing solo or in groups..</li> <li>Listen attentively, move to and talk about music, expressing their feelings and responses.</li> </ul>

ELG	Communication and language	<p><b><u>ELG: Listening, Attention and Understanding</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Listen attentively and respond to what they hear with relevant questions, comments and actions when being read to and during whole class discussions and small group interactions</li> <li>Make comments about what they have heard and ask questions to clarify their understanding.</li> </ul>
	Physical Development	<p><b><u>Fine motor skills</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Use a range of small tools, including scissors, paintbrushes and cutlery.</li> </ul>
	Expressive Arts and Design	<p><b><u>ELG: Being imaginative</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Sing a range of well-known nursery rhymes and song</li> <li>Perform songs, rhymes, poems and stories with others, and (when appropriate) try to move in time with music</li> </ul>
