		Crucifixion	A method of punishment in which the victim is tied or nailed to a large wooden beam and left to hang until eventual death from exhaustion and asphyxiation. It was used as a punishment by the Romans.	
		Resurrection	The concept of coming back to life after death.

Describe and make simple links between examples of religious expression found in art and the beliefs and ideas about Easter that underlie them. Explain how Christians use the arts to express something of the sacred and spiritual and as a means of reinforcing important stories/teachings about Easter. 	<p>Using the unit question <i>'What can people learn about Easter from the creative arts?'</i> ask groups of children to produce a chosen group piece of work e.g. dance, drama, art, writing and make a response to the question. Show case all responses and vote as a class on which pieces or ideas from different pieces of work they think best answer the question.</p>
