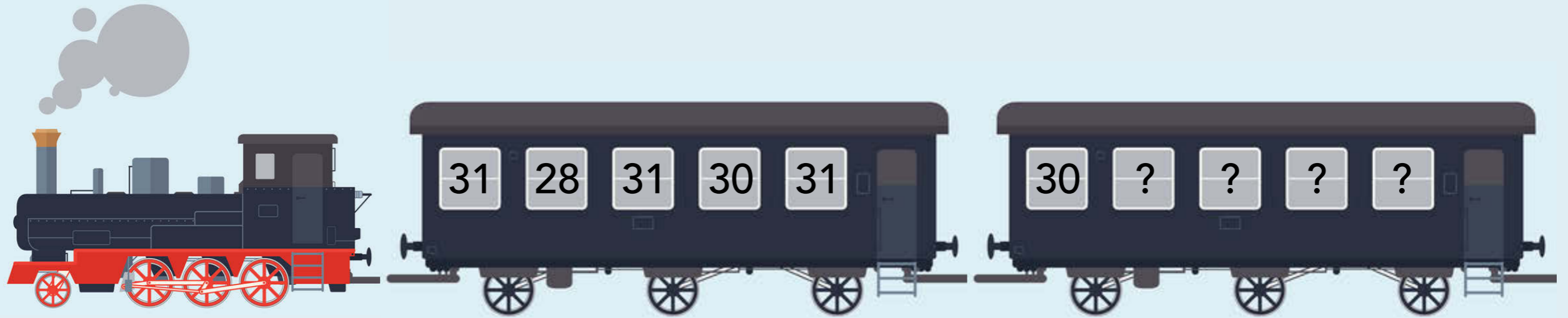

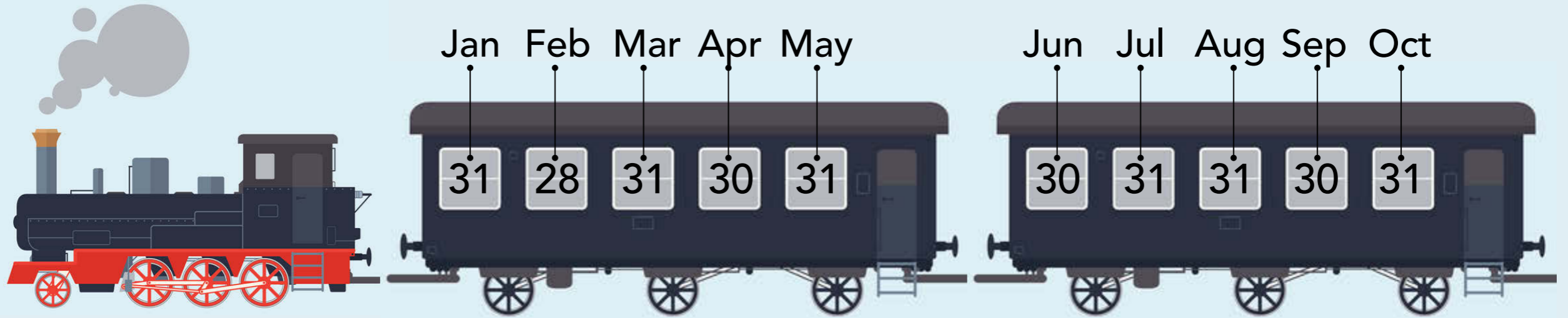

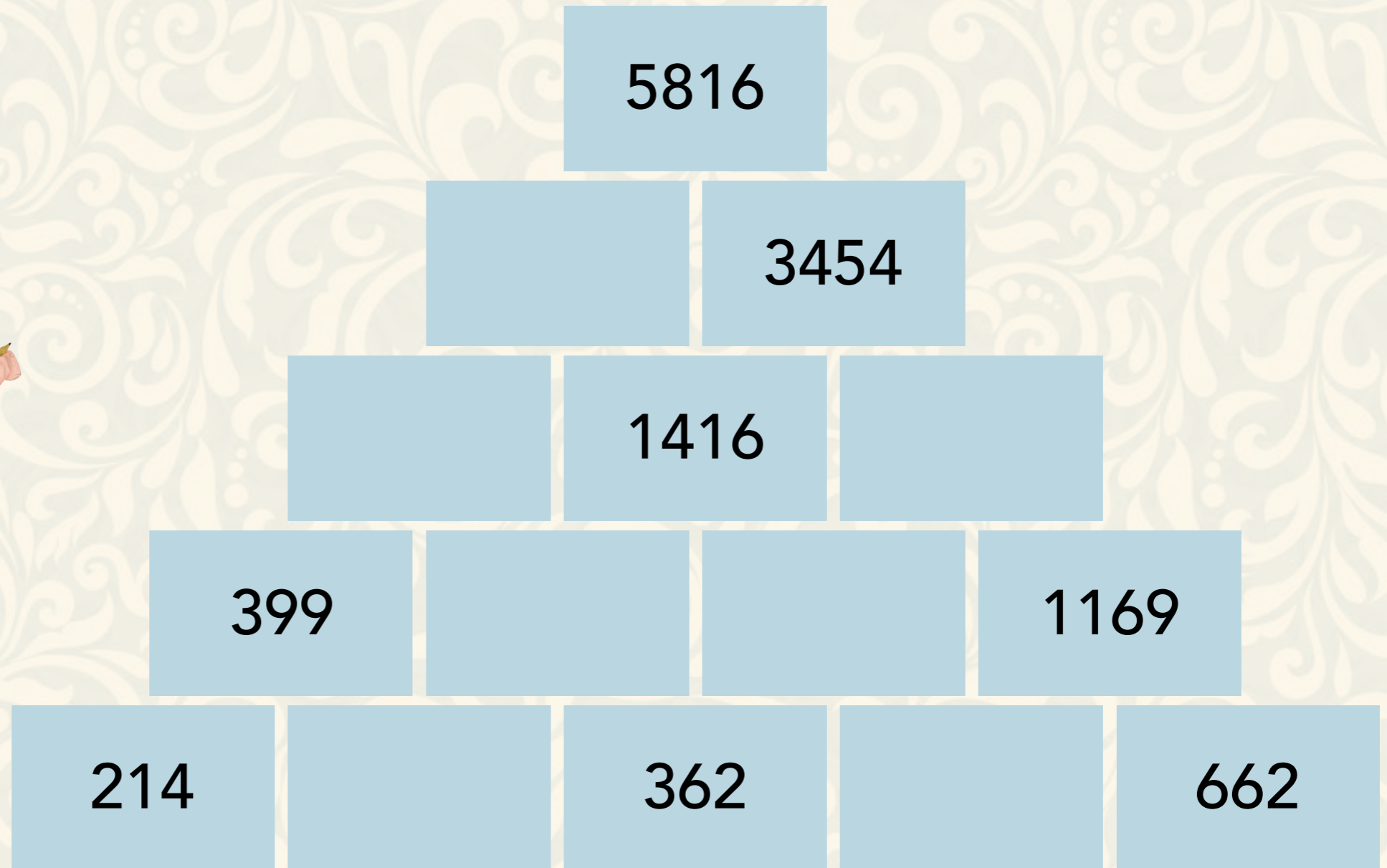

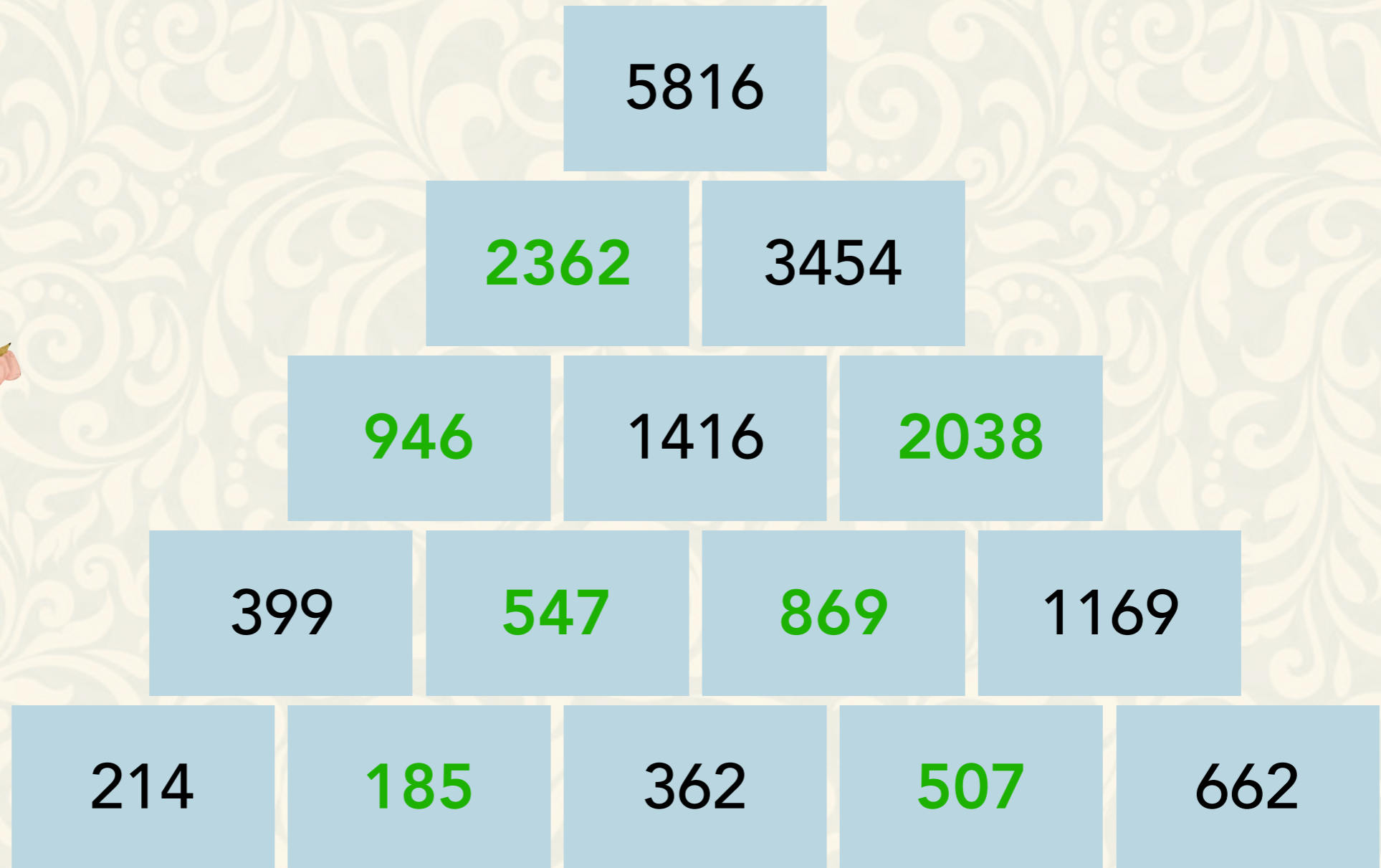
Can you fill in the blanks on this wall? Each pair of bricks adds up to the brick directly above it.

Each letter of the alphabet has a different value:

A	B	C	D	E	F	G	H	I	J	K	L	M
1	2	3	4	5	6	7	8	9	10	11	12	13
N	O	P	Q	R	S	T	U	V	W	X	Y	Z
14	15	16	17	18	19	20	21	22	23	24	25	26

For example, 'queen' has a value of **62**:

Q=17, **U**=21, **E**=5, **E**=5, **N**=14

$$17 + 21 + 5 + 5 + 14 = \mathbf{62}$$
